# City of Thunder Bay Outpatient RD Services, September 2019

## **Reason for referral:**

#### <u>Cancer</u>

- Cancer Program TBRHSC
  - Regional Cancer Program clients or with nutrition issues related to active cancer diagnosis.

## <u>Diabetes</u>

- St. Joseph's Care Group Diabetes Health Thunder Bay
  - Requires a pre-diabetes or diabetes diagnosis.
- Centre for Complex Diabetes Care (CCDC)
  - Must have co-morbidities associated with their diabetes.
- Anishnawbe Mushkiki Community Health and Wellness Centre
  - High risk, Prediabetes and Type 2 Diabetes

## Heart Disease

- Rehabilitation and Healthy Lifestyles Program TBRHSC
  - High Cardiovascular risk + any pre-existing cardiac related conditions
- Congestive Heart Failure TBRHSC
  - Must be registered with the CHF telehomecare program

## Mental Health/Addictions

- St. Joseph's Health Centre Community Mental Health Services
  - Must have a Mental Health Diagnosis
- Sister Margaret Smith Centre Eating Disorder Program
  - Medically stable clients with a diagnosed eating disorder residing in North western Ontario.
- Chronic Pain Management Program
  - Must be referred by a NP/MD

## **Obesity**

- Adult Bariatric Program TBRHSC
  - Surgical Program: BMI > 40 OR BMI > 35 with weight related co-morbidities
  - Medical Program:
    PML > 25 OR PML > 20 with your expectitio weight related on marbiditie
    - BMI >35 OR BMI > 30 with very specific weight related co-morbidities
- Pediatric Healthy Living Program TBRHSC

 BMI >99th percentile OR BMI > 97th percentile plus a significant obesity related co-morbidity

#### <u>Renal</u>

- Renal Services TBRHSC
  - Must be a registered patient with renal services.

#### **Rheumatology**

- St. Joseph's Care Group Rheumatology Program
  - Must be in the Rheumatology Day Program or receiving care by a Rheumatologist

#### <u>Stroke</u>

- Outpatient Stoke Clinic TBRHSC
  - For individuals who had a recent stroke or TIA, or who are at high risk.

#### <u>Wounds</u>

- St. Joseph's Care Group Wound Care Program
  - Must be in the wound care program under Dr. Migay or an Enterostomal RN

## **General Nutrition**

- General High Risk Nutrition TBRHSC
  - District of Thunder Bay adults with referral (ie. Inpatients requiring outpatient follow up or inpatient referrals not seen by RD in hospital). Mainly GI conditions.
- Maternity Centre TBRHSC
  - Prenatal or post-partum (<8 weeks) patients. Can self-refer.
- Anishnawbe Mushkiki Community Health and Wellness Centre
  - Must be a registered patient.
- Dilico Anishabek Family Care Primary Care Travelling Team
  - Services available in Thunder Bay most Mondays and Fridays for general population.
- Confederation College Health Centre
  - Must be a staff or student of Confederation College.
- Fort William Clinic
  - Must be a registered patient.
- Harbourview Family Health Team
  - Must be a registered patient.
- Lakehead Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic
  - Must be a registered patient.

- NorWest Community Health Centre
  - Must be a registered patient.
- Aspiria Employee Assistance Program
  - Must be an employee (or employee's immediate family member) of an organization that purchases EFAP services.
- Behavioural Sciences Centre Employee Assistance Program
  - Must be an employee (or employee's immediate family member) of an organization that purchases EFAP services.
- Shepell-fgi Employee Assistance Program
  - Must be an employee (or employee's immediate family member) of an organization that purchases EFAP services.
- North West LHIN (CCAC)
  - Must meet the eligibility requirements of home care services.
- Private Practice Cornerstone Clinic (Catherine Semenick)
- Private Practice Oak Medical Clinic (Kelly Keeler)
- Private Practice You + Food (Saara Rizzo)
